### **Word Study : Zion**

Our observations in the past can lead us to a clear understanding about the new man. The new man is also known as inner man, hidden man, new creation, greater one in you, and so on. We have seen the new man reflected, in mention of Zion more than once.

*Psalms 9:11 Sing praises to the Lord, which dwelleth in Zion: declare among the people his doings.*

Observe the word "Dwelleth". Those who dwell or stay or live in Zion are exhorted to sing praises.

It is a similar exhortation in the new covenant when the apostles tell us to live in the spirit (Spirit) and to walk in the spirit.(Spirit) Galatians 5:16 and 5:25. Are we not asked to give thanks as well?

Our inner man has been given to us so that the Spirit of God can dwell in us. Please see what Apostle Paul says in Romans *"but if the Spirit of HIM who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, then \_\_\_\_\_"*. In this context the Spirit of God is His Divine attribute.

It is not possible to have His divine perfection in us unless, He Himself has laid the foundation in **us** and that foundational work in **us** is the new man which we know has been designed in us by the imperishable Word of God.

We are called to live in the new man; which is this spiritual Zion and which has been raised up for us. When we live in this new man we also will declare HIS Works. We are more equipped to manifest His Good Works.

By faith we will do it because Faithful is the ONE who promised. We conclude then that the new man is a creation of God and we need to live in that new man.

Here are seven practical and commonly understandable guidelines to walk in the Spirit (spirit).

1. Hold on to the new conscience given to us.
2. Be Spiritually upright; knowing that forgiveness and obedience are spiritual laws that must be complied to all times.
3. Exercise the character of the Lord; Pray this prayer that we may be empowered to manifest the divine nature at all times.

4. Ask and be a life of giving; giving of time, money, ability at all times. Commit all that you have to HIM and humbly request HIM to take what HE wants from that.

5. Have fellowship with likeminded and with those who have known HIM more than we have so that we may be mature in HIS ways.

6. Pray in the spirit and with the help of the spirit.

7. Give thanks purposefully and definitely.

## Heroes of Faith - William Carey

(Continued from earlier edition)

### Last Days of William Carey

Carey's last will and testament begins. "I utterly disclaim all or any right or title to the premises at Serampore, called the mission premise, and every part and parcel thereof; and do hereby declare that I never had, or supposed myself to have, any such right or title." Unto his children he passed on no wealth. He had paid Felix and William Rs.1500 in his lifetime. In order to have a like sum to Jabez, he thus provided: "From failure of funds to carry my former intentions into effect, I direct that my library be sold."

Yet he provided unto his children the eternal riches. Like their father, his children too seldom looked at the temporal riches and cast their eyes on the eternal riches in heaven which 'neither the moth nor rust doth corrupt nor where thieves do not break through nor steal.'

Carey never had time to look after his children. But his children always saw Carey looking at Jesus and they too learnt that. Felix, William, Jabez went on to become missionaries. Felix Carey was a Medical missionary of great skill, a printer of the oriental languages trained by Ward, a scholar especially in Sanskrit, Pali and Burman. He prepared a Folio Dictionary of Burmese and Pali, translated several Buddhist shartras in English and several of the Holy Scriptures into the vernacular.

Just before Dr. Carey's death, Alexander Duff arrived in India, a young man of twenty-four out on his own life work he went to see the man who had changed the face of the world. He reached the college and there he was 'the little yellow man in white jacket', who tottered up to the visitor, received his greeting and with outstretched hands solemnly blessed him. Carey standing on the brink of his grave rejoiced to see a young Scotsman dedicating his life to evangelization and emancipation of India both men fell in love with each other.

Not long before, Carey lay dying and to his great delight Diff came to see him. The young man told Carey of his great admiration and love for him. "Mr. Duff", said the dying man, "you have been speaking about Dr. Carey, Dr. Carey, Dr. Carey! When I am gone, say nothing about Dr. Carey. Speak only of Dr. Carey's Savior."

On the morning of the 9<sup>th</sup> of June 1834, the aged saint entered into rest. On the morning of following day he was carried to his burial. Rain was falling heavily and this intensified the general gloom. The Danish Governor and his wife and the members of the Council joined the long procession of mourners, and the Danish Flag hung at half mast as on the occasion of death of a Governor. The road was lined with poor Hindu and Mohammedans who felt that they had lost a true friend. When the cemetery was reached and a halt was made at the open grave, the sun burst forth in splendor. A resurrection hymn was sung and the mortal remains were laid to rest.

Dr. Carey died possessed of little worldly wealth, but he had contributed to the work of evangelization and civilization in India, £46,000. The three mission families from their earnings had contributed a munificent sum of £90,000. His valuable museum was bequeathed to the college, together with his collection of the Bibles, and he directed that his only memorial should be the following inscription, cut on the stone above the grave of his second wife:

Born August 17, 1761; Died June 9, 1834.

A wretched, poor, and helpless worm, On Thy Kind arms I fall.

## Recipe Corner

### Peanut Butter Cookies

#### Ingredients:

2 Cups – All Purpose Flour

1 ½ tsp - Baking Powder

½ tsp – Baking Soda

¾ Cup – Butter

½ Cup – White Sugar

¾ Cup – Peanut Butter

1 – Large Egg

1 tsp – Vanilla

**Directions:** First mix all dry ingredients, then mix the all wet ingredients. Combine both and mix well. Chill this for one hour in refrigerator. Preheat the oven at 350<sup>0</sup> F. Make balls of about 1” size and Place 2 inches apart onto a cookie sheets for baking and flatten balls in criss-cross pattern using a fork. Bake it for 10mts/till the edges gets brown. You can store the cookies for several days. Freeze it for longer time.




